NOTICE TO RADIO APPARATUS LICENSEES REGARDING LICENCE FEES

Pursuant to section 7 of the Telecommunications and Radiocommunications Act 2009 (“the Act”) and section 4(1) of the Radio Apparatus Licence and Spectrum Licence (Fees) Regulation 2012 (“Regulation”), the Telecommunications and Radiocommunications Regulator (TRR) wishes to inform *all registered Marine Vessel Owners, Aircraft Owners, and other radio apparatus operators of their requirement to pay any 2014 outstanding fees, and/or renew their Radio apparatus Licence for 2015 based on the new prescribed fees as determined by the Regulator.* Given that **cob 19th of December 2014**, is our office closure for the festive season, we know that not all Radio apparatus licensees have settled their outstanding fees for 2014, or renewal fees for 2015.

Given the period (as advised to Licensees) for radio licence renewal has now passed, and because not all registered licensees have paid their renewal fees, TRR will give a grace period for payment until the 9th of January 2015, for registered licensees to settle their outstanding 2014 debts and renew their 2015 licences based on the new prescribed fees for 2015. That grace period has been given to cover the festive season break when TRR’s Office will close and it provides another opportunity to ensure that you are not contravening the Act.

It is a one-off grace period and no further extensions will be given. *Late payment fees will apply and enforced for any holders/users of radio apparatus who seek to pay such fees after this date.*

This reminder serves to inform holders/users of radio apparatus to ensure that they are not operating contrary to the Act and the Regulation as far as regulating radiocommunications apparatus is concerned. If any holders/users of radio apparatus fail to pay the prescribed fee, it means that they are contravening the Act by operating without a valid licence; and for which a penalty may apply.

TRR wishes to thank all licences who have already paid their fees and appeals to radio apparatus operators who already have been notified by letter or email to come to TRR to settle their fee payments as soon as possible on 5 January 2015 when our office resume official duty; and before the grace period date.

TRR has now closed its doors (at COB on Friday 19th December 2014) and the Office will remain closed throughout the festive season; reopening again for normal hours of operation on Monday 5th January 2015.
