Subject: Comment on current .vu consultation

Hello

This is a brief note to express support for the proposal by TRR to develop a Shared Registry System for the .vu domain name space. nz (New Zealand) moved to such a system back in 2002 and now enjoy a competitive environment with many authorised registrars working effectively with the .nz registry, and with the .nz Domain Name Commission

I note the proposed regulations and consider them very detailed and they show the extensive thinking that has gone into this change. There does appear to be some aspects that have not been fully defined and this does raise some questions around the detailed implementation of the change.

As TRR are proposing regulations to set out how .vu will operate, I would pose a question of how any changes may be made in future with this approach. One option that I would suggest to TRR and .vu is to have regulations setting out how the space will be managed and policy developed but then complement that with a policy framework with more specific details that are developed through an open consultation process with the Local Internet Community.
