PUBLIC NOTICE Radio (Apparatus) Licence Renewal

The Telecommunications, Radiocommunications and Broadcasting Regulator (TRBR) wishes to remind all users of a Radio Apparatus that all Licenses must be renewed before the 31st of December 2018.

In accordance to Section 12 (2) of the Telecommunications Radiocommunications Broadcasting Regulation Act No 30 of 2009 as amended by Amendment 22 of 2018 (the Act) which states that,

A person must not install or operate a Radiocommunications device in Vanuatus or its territorial waters or airspace, or in any ship or aircraft registered in or infer the law of Vanuatu, except:

- (i) under and in accordance with a license or exception; or
- (ii) When such Radiocommunications device is registered for use by a foreign registered ship or aircraft for the appropriate class of operation in the country of registration of the ship or aircraft.

TRBR, therefore advises that all Radio (Apparatus) licensees will have to renew their annual licence before the expiry date. All outstanding fees must be cleared before renewing licence. Failure to do so will mean that you have breached the Act.
