

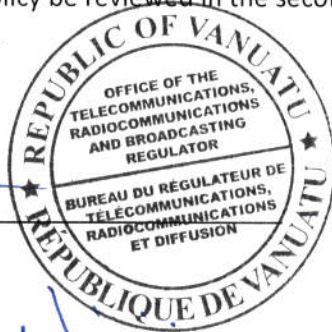


INTERIM POLICY FOR MODERATION OF .VU DOMAIN NAMES

1. Under the .vu Regulation, the following 2nd Level Names are to be moderated:
 - a. .com.vu
 - b. .net.vu
 - c. .org.vu
 - d. .gov.vu
 - e. .edu.vu
 - f. .nic.vu
2. TRBR appoints a Registrar for all five moderated 2nd level names who can accept Registrations and Changes to any moderated name, but will place the Registration into a "Pending Create" queue, and changes to Registrant information are logged and made available to review
3. TRBR will be notified by email from Neustar that they will need to review a pending registration of a moderated name; and changes to Registrant information are logged and made available for review
4. TRBR will approve any sensible Registration for .com.vu, .net.vu or .org.vu names, that comply with the names policy i.e. that TRBR is the moderator for these three second level names, TRBR will periodically review the Registrant changes file
5. OGCIO is appointed the Moderator for all names in .gov.vu
6. TRBR will email OGCIO with information relating to Registration to any .gov.vu name, and will require an email response either accepting or rejecting the Registration. If accepted by OGCIO, TRBR will release the Registration from "Pending" to "Live". TRBR will notify OGCIO of relevant or suspicious changes in the Registrant changes file

7. A Moderator is required for .edu.vu, which might be OGCIO if they are willing, or alternatively that someone in the Department of Education, TRBR to discuss with OGCIO first, and if they do not wish to moderate .edu.vu, then they will discuss with the Department of Education.
8. Same action as outlined in 6. above for any Registration or Registrant Change to .edu.vu. The audit trail for authorizations will therefore be by email from the moderators of .gov.vu and .edu.vu
9. That it be noted that there are 15 domain names registered in .edu.vu and 85 in .gov.vu so it is not anticipated that there will be much additional workload from these low numbers.
10. That this interim policy be reviewed in the second quarter of year 2020, and may go to public consultation.
