

## TELECOMMUNICATIONS AND RADIOCOMMUNICATIONS REGULATION ACT NO. 30 OF 2009

### Requirement for licensee to provide information to the Regulator Notice No. 73 of 2020

Pursuant to section 16G of Telecommunications and Radiocommunications Regulation Act No. 30 of 2009, the Regulator, make the following Notice.

#### **1 Requirement to provide information**

- (1) A broadcasting licensee in Vanuatu must provide to the Regulator, any agreement or contract or subscription or free to air agreement made between any national or international broadcasting operators and broadcasting licensee for re-broadcasting through its network, within 30 days from the commencement of this Order
- (2) A broadcasting licensee in Vanuatu must provide to the Regulator, any agreement or contract or subscription or free to air agreement made between any:
  - (a) national broadcasting operator; or
  - (b) international broadcasting operator; or
  - (c) national and international content provider with content proprietary rights;

and the broadcasting licensee, for broadcasting or re-broadcasting through its network, entered into after the commencement of this Order and within 30 days from the commencement of their agreement or contract or subscriptions or free to air agreement.



- (3) Subject to clause 2, a Broadcasting Licensee in Vanuatu must not broadcast or re-broadcast content, or signals or channels, either paid or free to air, if he or she does not have the necessary agreements, contracts, subscriptions or free to air agreement between any national, international broadcasting operators or content provider with the content proprietary rights and the local broadcasting licensee for broadcasting or re-broadcasting through their network.
- (4) The Regulator may request from a licensee additional data from time to time for the performance of its functions and duties in accordance with the Telecommunications, Radiocommunications and Broadcasting Regulation Act No. 30 of 2009.

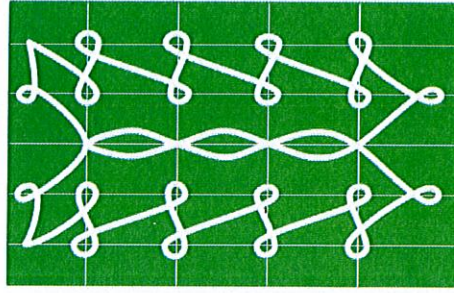


**MONTHLY ADJUSTED PRICE OF ELECTRICITY FOR MALEKULA,  
TANNA AND PORT VILA FOR JULY 2020**

**Notice No. ~~74~~ of 2020**

In the exercise of the powers conferred upon the Authority by subsection 13(1) of the Utilities Regulatory Authority Act No.11 of 2007 (as amended) and in light of the Arbitration Award of 28<sup>th</sup> April 2011 the Authority makes the following approval of UNELCO's monthly adjusted electricity price for the concessions of Malekula, Tanna and Port Vila.

- 1 Monthly Adjusted Price of Electricity to be charged by UNELCO**  
The Authority approves UNELCO's monthly adjusted price of electricity of **43.52 VT/kWh** to be charged to electricity consumers of Malekula, Tanna and Port Vila.
- 2 Monthly Adjustment Formula and Parameters**
  - (1) The monthly adjustment formula and parameters used to adjust the price, as submitted to the Authority by UNELCO, are set out in the schedule.
- 3 Application of the Monthly Adjusted Price**  
The monthly adjusted price applies to electricity customers of the concessions of Port Vila, Tanna and Malekula for the month of July 2020.
- 4 Commencement date**  
This Approval is deemed to commence on 8<sup>th</sup> of July 2020.
