The theme of the day is: **“WORLD ICT DAY”**

The ICT Day will combine two main objectives:

1. Demonstration of the practical applications of ICT which Vanuatu consumers and businesses can relate to by way of an Industrial Showcase. This event should give all participants a significant promotional platform. Industries and Authorities will have the opportunity to exhibit the practical applications of ICT in their allocated booth to demonstrate how ICT tools and devices can have a positive impact on their work and lives.
2. ITU celebrates Women and Girls in ICT on the fourth Thursday of April annually. This year it falls on the 26th of April however, we will cover this important theme on 18th May. A group of selected women and girls will have approximately ten minutes on the stage to talk about their success story and the benefits ICT has had to achieve their goals and aspirations.

The showcase will focus on:

- Applications of ICT in key industries such as: tourism, power, agriculture, fisheries & government;
- How ICT can create small business opportunities for people;
- How ICT has provided the opportunity and empowered individuals to achieve their goals and aspirations;
- How ICT can eliminate gender disparities and empower women and girls in entrepreneurial development;
- Information related to the use of ICT and ways ICT can provide avenues of advancement in seeking new opportunities.
