## TELECOMMUNICATIONS, RADIOCOMMUNICATIONS AND BROADCASTING REGULATION ACT NO. 30 OF 2009

#### Telecommunication Licence Regulation Order No. 221 of 2023

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by paragraph 7(4)(b) and subsections 13(3) and (4) and section 14 of the Telecommunications, Radiocommunications and Broadcasting Regulation Act No. 30 of 2009, I, BRIAN WINJI MOLITAVITI, Telecommunications, Radiocommunications and Broadcasting Regulator, with the approval of the Prime Minister, make the following Order.

#### PART 1 PRELIMINARY MATTERS

#### 1 Definitions

In this Regulation, unless the context otherwise requires:

**Act** means the Telecommunications, Radiocommunications and Broadcasting Regulation Act No. 30 of 2009;

class licence means a licence that provides for all services including satellite services, that do not have both-way connectivity with public networks, and reselling of service. The class licence category excludes Radio Paging and Public Mobile Radio Trunking Systems (PMRTS) Services but includes Niche Operators;

financial year means a 12 month period that is:

- (a) nominated for the purpose of this Regulation by a licensee and advised to the Regulator; or
- (b) the 12 month commencing on 1 January and ending on 31 December of the following year;

**individual content provider licence** means a licence that provides for the supply of television or radio broadcast services, or the supply of narrow-cast services that supplies content intended for a restricted number of viewers or listeners;

**individual general licence** means a licence that provides for all public networks including switched networks irrespective of media and technology capable of offering voice or non-voice (data services) including Internet Telephony, Cable Television (TV), Direct To Home (DTH), TV & Radio Broadcasting;

#### individual network operator license means a network licence that:

- (a) is required to construct, maintain, own, and operate facilities for a communications network such as VSATs, towers, lines, antenna, and earth stations; and
- (b) allows for, among others, services for carrying electronic communications such as public cellular mobile services and broadcasting distribution services;

**individual service provider license** means a licence that provides for the supply of certain communication services using a network service such as PSTN telephony services, IP telephony services, internet access services, messaging services, and audio text services;

**licensee** means a person who is issued with a licence under this Regulation.

#### PART 2 INDIVIDUAL GENERAL LICENCE

#### 2 Application

- (1) A person must apply to the Regulator for an individual general licence.
- (2) The application for an individual general licence must:
  - (a) be in the approved form set out under Schedule 1; and
  - (b) be accompanied with the fee set out under table 1 of Schedule 3.

#### 3 Issuing of an individual general licence

- (1) The Regulator upon receiving an application under clause 2 may:
  - (a) issue an individual general licence with or without conditions; or
  - (b) refuse to issue an individual general licence.
- (2) The Regulator may issue an individual general licence to an applicant if the Regulator is satisfied that the applicant complies with the requirements under this Regulation and the Act and any other Act for issuing an individual general licence.
- (3) The Regulator may, in writing, require the applicant to provide additional information or documents within a specific time.
- (4) The Regulator must notify the applicant, in writing, of his or her decision within 30 working days after receiving the application or additional information.
- (5) If the Regulator refuses to issue a licence, the notification given under subclause (4), must include the reasons for the decision.
- (6) The term of licence is to be set out in the licence.

#### 4 Renewal of an individual general licence

(1) The licensee must apply to the Regulator to have his or her general individual licence renewed.

- (2) The application under subclause (1) must:
  - (a) be made 3 months prior to the expiry of the licence; and
  - (b) be in the approved form set out under Schedule 2; and
  - (c) be accompanied with the fee set out under table 2 of Schedule 3.
- (3) Subject to subsection 15(7) of the Act, the Regulator in deciding whether to:
  - (a) renew the licence, must ensure that the conditions under subclause (2) are being met; or
  - (b) deny the renewal of the licence, must ensure that the grounds under paragraphs (7)(a) and (b) of the Act are being met.
- (4) If a licensee fails to apply for the renewal of the individual general licence within the period set out under paragraph 2(a), the licensee may apply 21 days after the expiry of the licence and accompanied with the late renewal fee set out under table 5 of Schedule 3.

#### 5 Revocation of an individual general licence

The Regulator may revoke an individual general licence in accordance to section 15 of the Act.

#### PART 3 INDIVIDUAL NETWORK OPERATOR LICENCE

#### 6 Application

- (1) A person must apply to the Regulator for an individual network operator licence.
- (2) The application for an individual network operator licence must:
  - (a) be in the approved form set out under Schedule 1; and
  - (b) be accompanied with the fee set out under table 1 of Schedule 3.

#### 7 Issuing of an individual network operator licence

- (1) Subject to subclause (2), the Regulator when receiving an application under clause 6 may:
  - (a) issue an individual network operator licence with or without conditions or restrictions to a licensee; or
  - (b) refuse to issue an individual network operator licence to a licensee.
- (2) The Regulator may issue an individual network operator licence to the applicant if the Regulator is satisfied that the applicant intends to provide telecommunications services or content services using telecommunications network facilities.
- (3) The Regulator may impose all or any of the following conditions in an individual network operator licence:
  - (a) the licensee must pay all applicable licence fees and levees in a quarterly basis;
  - (b) the licensee must not obtain an individual service provider licence and an individual content provider licence unless an approval to obtain the licences is given by the Regulator;
  - (c) the licensee must comply with the Act and any other relevant Act, Regulations, Orders or directions;
  - (d) the licensee must take all reasonable steps to ensure that the charging mechanism used in connection with any of its facilities

and services are accurate and reliable in all material aspects and remains accurate and reliable;

- the licensee must indemnify the Regulator against any claims or (e) proceedings arising from any breaches or failures caused by the licensee;
- (f) any other conditions that the Regulator considers necessary.
- (4) An individual network operator licensee may:
  - control and operate telecommunications network facilities in (a) Vanuatu, for the purpose of providing telecommunications services; and
  - (b) provide services under an individual service provider licence and publish content under an individual content provider licence.
- (5) The Regulator may issue an individual network operator licence as a unified licence.
- The unified licence issued under subclause (5) authorizes the licensee to (6)provide any telecommunications services or content other than broadcasting service content.
- (7) To avoid doubt,
  - an individual network operator licensee is not required to apply for (a) or to have:
    - (i) a separate individual service provider licence; or
    - (ii) an individual content provider licence, and
  - (b) the applicant under this Part is limited only to the services proposed within the scope of the individual network operator licence.
- (8) The services eligible to be issued licence under this Part is provided under tables 1, 2 and 4 of Schedule 4.

#### 8 Renewal of an individual network operator licence

- (1) The licensee must apply to the Regulator to have his or her individual network operator licence renewed.
- (2) The application under subclause (1) must:
  - (a) be made 3 months prior to the expiry of the licence; and
  - (b) be in the approved form set out under Schedule 2; and
  - (b) be accompanied with a fee set out under table 2 of Schedule 3.
- (3) Subject to subsection 15(7) of the Act, the Regulator in deciding whether to:
  - (a) renew the licence, must ensure that the conditions under subclause (2) are being met; or
  - (b) deny the renewal of the licence, must ensure that the grounds under paragraphs 7(a) and (b) of the Act are being met.
- (4) If a licensee fails to apply for the renewal of the individual network operator licence within the period set out under paragraph 2(a), the licensee may apply 21 days after the expiry of the licence and accompanied with the late renewal fee set out under table 5 of Schedule 3.

#### 9 Revocation of an individual general licence

The Regulator may revoke an individual network operator licence in accordance to section 15 of the Act.

#### PART 4 INDIVIDUAL SERVICE PROVIDER LICENCE

#### 10 Application

- (1) A service provider who intends to apply for an individual service provider licence, must apply to the Regulator.
- (2) The application must:
  - (a) be in the approved form set out under Schedule 1; and
  - (b) be accompanied with the fee set out under table 1 of Schedule 3.

#### 11 Issuing of an individual service provider licence

- (1) Subject to subclause (2), the Regulator when receiving an application under clause 10 may:
  - (a) issue an individual service provider licence with or without conditions; or
  - (b) refuse to issue an individual service provider licence.
- (2) The Regulator must not issue an individual service provider licence to a service provider unless the Regulator is satisfied that the service provider intends:
  - (a) to provide telecommunications services; or
  - (b) to use telecommunications network facilities and detailed rollout plan controlled and operated by a network operator licensee.
- (3) The Regulator may impose all or any of the following conditions on an individual service provider licence:
  - (a) the licensee must get an approval from the Regulator to operate the supply of content service;
  - (b) the conditions set out under paragraphs 7(3)(a), (c), (d), (e) and (f) of this Regulation.
- (4) The conditions under subclause 15(4) may apply:

- (a) to all individual service provider licence; or
- (b) to individual service provider licence in the nominated categories set out under Schedule 4.
- (5) The services that are eligible to be issued with the licence under this Part is provided under table 1 of Schedule 4.

#### 12 Renewal of an individual service provider licence

- (1) The licensee must apply to the Regulator to have his or individual service provider licence renewed.
- (2) The application under subclause (1) must:
  - (a) be made 3 months prior to the expiry of the licence; and
  - (b) be in the approved form set out under Schedule 2; and
  - (b) be accompanied with a fee set out under table 2 of Schedule 3.
- (3) Subject to subsection 15(7) of the Act, the Regulator in deciding whether to:
  - (a) renew the licence, must ensure that the conditions under subclause (2) are being met; or
  - (b) deny the renewal of the licence, must ensure that the grounds under paragraphs 7(a) and (b) of the Act are being met.
- (4) If a licensee fails to apply for the renewal of the individual service provider licence within the period set out under paragraph 2(a), the licensee may apply 21 days after the expiry of the licence and accompanied with the late renewal fee set out under table 5 of Schedule 3.

#### 13 Revocation of an Individual service provider licence

The Regulator may revoke an individual network operator licence in accordance to section 15 of the Act.

#### PART 5 INDIVIDUAL CONTENT PROVIDER LICENCE

#### 14 Application

- (1) A service provider who intends to apply for an individual content provider licence, must apply to the Regulator.
- (2) The application must:
  - (a) be in the approved form set out under Schedule 1; and
  - (b) be accompanied with the fee set out under table 1 of Schedule 3; and
  - (c) specify the type of services under subclause (3).
- (3) A licensee under this Part may provide services on:
  - (i) a community service basis; or
  - (ii) a commercial basis.

#### 15 Issuing of an individual content provider licence

- (1) Subject to subclause (2), the Regulator when receiving an application may:
  - (a) issue an individual content provider licence with or without conditions; or
  - (b) refuse to issue an individual content provider licence.
- (2) The Regulator must issue an individual content provider licence to a service provider if the Regulator is satisfied that the service provider intends to provide content in any of the following mode:
  - (a) an audio mode; or
  - (b) a video mode; or
  - (c) a text mode.

- (3) A mode under subclause (2) must be provided as a separate service associated with:
  - (a) a telecommunications network services provided by a network operator licensee; or
  - (b) a telecommunications service provided by a service provider.
- (4) The Regulator may impose all or any of the following conditions in an individual content provider licence:
  - (a) the licensee must seek approval from the Regulator to provide content services and must provide such information on the business plans and other detail of the content as the Regulator may require;
  - (b) the conditions set out under paragraphs 7(3)(a), (c), (d), (e) and (f) of this Regulation.

#### 16 Renewal of an individual content provider licence

- (1) The licensee must apply to the Regulator to have his or individual content provider licence renewed.
- (2) The application under subclause (1) must:
  - (a) be made 3 months prior to the expiry of the licence; and
  - (b) be in the approved form set out under Schedule 2; and
  - (b) be accompanied with a fee set out under table 2 of Schedule 3.
- (3) Subject to subsection 15(7) of the Act, the Regulator in deciding whether to:
  - (a) renew the licence, must ensure that the conditions under subclause (2) are being met; or
  - (b) deny the renewal of the licence, must ensure that the grounds under paragraphs 7(a) and (b) of the Act are being met.

(4) If a licensee fails to apply for the renewal of the individual content provider licence within the period set out under paragraph 2(a), the licensee may apply 21 days after the expiry of the licence and accompanied with the late renewal fee set out under table 5 of Schedule 3.

#### 17 Revocation of an individual content provider licence

The Regulator may revoke an individual network operator licence in accordance to section 15 of the Act.

#### PART 6 CLASS LICENCE

#### 18 Establishment of class licence

- (1) The Regulator may establish class licensing arrangement for the control and operation of telecommunications network facilities for the purposes of telecommunication services and content services.
- (2) Without limiting subclause (1), the Regulator may also establish class licensing arrangement for the control and operation of telecommunications network facilities for the purposes of another service if:
  - (a) the service is provided as a complete service for resale to retail customers by the service provider; or
  - (b) the service is an incidental part of a non-telecommunications services provided by the service provider such as access to telecommunications services to hotel guests; or
  - (c) the eligible criteria and conditions associated with licensing to provide the service are simple and clear and does not require the intercession of the Regulator through an individual application process.

#### 19 Application to register a class licence

- (1) A person must apply to the Regulator to be registered for a class licence.
- (2) The application under subclause (1) must:
  - (a) be in the approved form set out under Schedule 14; and
  - (b) be accompanied with:
    - (i) a fee set out under table 1 of Schedule 3; and
    - (ii) a complete Registration form set out under Schedule 5.
- (3) The Registrar must in writing, within 30 days after receiving the applications:
  - (a) inform the applicant on whether his or her application is accepted; and

(b) clarify to the applicant any matters that arises from his or her application.

#### 20 Obligations to provide accurate information

A class licensee must notify the Regulator in writing of any changes or inaccuracy in:

- (a) its corporate details; or
- (b) its description; or
- (c) the scope of its telecommunication systems and services; or
- (d) any other information submitted to the Regulator.

#### 21 De-registration of a class licence

The Regulator may de-register a class licence if the licensee:

- (a) is in breach of any of the conditions attached to the licence; or
- (b) fails to rectify the breach within 14 days after the Regulator has notified the licensee of the breach; or
- (c) requests the Regulator in writing to de-register his or her licence; or
- (d) ceases to carry on with the activity for which the licence is issued; or
- (e) is unable to pay its debts; or
- (f) is in liquidation; or
- (g) is declared insolvent; or
- (h) is convicted of any fraudulent activity by a Court of a competent jurisdiction.

#### PART 7 ANNUAL RETURNS

#### 22 Annual returns

- (1) A licensee must, within 3 months before the end of his or her financial year, produce the following documents to the Regulator:
  - (a) a return of the financial year reporting:
    - (i) the amount of the annual gross revenue; and
    - (ii) the amount of settlement charges payable to or receivable from another licensee; and
    - (iii) the method by which amount under subparagraph (ii) is to be calculated; and
  - (b) a statement showing a calculation of the charges for the licence fee that would be payable in respect of the annual gross revenue net of the settlements as set out in the return.
- (2) The return must include a certificate stating that it is true and correct and signed by the licensee.
- (3) If a licensee fails to provide the final return within 3 months after the end of the licensee's financial year, the licensee may lodge a provisional return to cover the same 3 months applicable to that licensee to:
  - (a) clearly identifies its return as a provisional return; and
  - (b) submit a final return within 6 months of the licensee's financial year.
- (4) A licensee who:
  - (a) provides a false report for the purpose of his or her annual return; or
  - (b) fails to comply with the submission of the annual returns,

commits an offence and is liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding VT1.000.000.

#### 23 Commencement

This Regulation commences on the day on which it is made.
