TRBR TYPE APPROVAL IMPORTATION OF RTTE, RADIOCOMMUNICATION, BROADCASTING AND SATELLITE EQUIPMENT NOTICE

The Office of the Telecommunications, Radiocommunications and Broadcasting Regulator (TRBR) is mandated to regulate the telecommunications and broadcasting industry by the Telecommunications Radiocommunications and Broadcasting Regulation Act No. 30 of 2009 as amended by Amendment 22 of 2018 (the Act).

Pursuant to Section 7 of the TRBR Act 30 of 2009 as amended prescribes the general functions and powers of TRBR. Subsection 7(3) and 7(4)(f) of the Act states:

7(3) *“The Regulator may, with the approval of the Minister, make such regulations as may be necessary or convenient to give effect to the provisions of this Act”, and;*

7(4) (f) *“imposing restrictions or limitations upon the importation, sale or use of any equipment used or likely to be used in connection with radiocommunications or telecommunications*

In Accordance with the Act, TRBR is providing this Notice to Inform the public that any Importation of **Radio and Telecommunications Terminal Equipment (RTTE), Broadcasting and Satellite** equipment into the country must have a **TRBR type approval Import Permit** specifying the Brand and Model of the equipment being imported. The Import Permits must be processed by a recognised Customs Broker who has access to the Government Single Window system.

Importation of any Equipment that has no TRBR permit, will be subjected to Customs detaining the equipment at the ports of entry until such time when a TRBR permit is provided, before the equipment can be released.
