SUBJECT: Notice of Revocation of Telsat Broadband LTD Telecom Licence

The Telecommunications Radiocommunications, and Broadcast Regulator (TRBR) is writing to you to formally inform you that given the current state of your business operation, it is not necessary for you to continue to maintain a Telecommunications. Reason being that;

1. Under clause 1.1 (a) of your license, it states that the license authorises Telsat Broadband LTD to provide telecommunication services to end users in Vanuatu. To TRBR's understanding and confirmation, Telsat no longer provides telecom services as the broadband business has now been acquired by Wantok.

The Office, confirms the formal request via email dated 24th November 2020 requesting confirmation for revocation of your licence, as such, TRBR wishes to formally inform you that Telsat Broadband Ltd telecommunication licence is hereby, revoked as of 24th November 2020 in accordance Clause 4.1 (a) of your telecommunication licence and specifically Section 15.1(a) of the TRBR Act as amended by Amendment No. 22 of 2018, which stipulates as follows:-


The Regulator may amend the terms of and conditions of, or revoke this licence if;

- (a) The amendment or revocation has been requested or agreed to by the licensee.*

The revocation does not, nor will not in the future, restrict you in anyway as the owner of Telsat broadband LTD, to re-apply for a license.
